City Campus hereby invites applications from all students enrolled in the Bachelor's program at City Campus to apply for the innovative and interactive university-level extracurricular civic education course titled "*Democracy: From Theory to Practice*" for the academic year 2025 (in-person). Interested students must apply for enrollment no later than **23 February 2025**.

This course is being offered by Lumbini Buddhist University, in collaboration with the International Foundation for Electoral Systems (IFES) and supported by USAID.

The course aims to address the critical question of where, when, and how citizens develop the ability to defend their own rights and responsibilities as well as those of others, to value diversity, to champion equal opportunities, and to actively participate in democratic life. The guiding principle of this course is that democratic citizens are made, not born, and that, in today's context, citizens must be equipped to counter challenges such as disinformation, exclusion, and populism.

The course will incorporate interactive civic education teaching methodologies to create a student-centered classroom environment.
