Syllabus for B.A.LL.B. Entrance Examination

Entrance exam eligibility

To get admission to the BALLB Program at Lumbini Buddhist University, applicants /candidates should secure a position in the merit list published after the Entrance Examination. They should fill out an application form before they can appear in the Entrance Examination.

Entrance examination will be conducted by the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. Applicants who have passed Secondary Level/Education (or +2) with at least 2.5 CGPA in the scale of 4 (or at least Second Division marks) may appear in the Entrance Examination. They may write their answers either in English or Nepali language.
